



## SUMMER 2007 BILL CALCULATION

The amount of your gas bill is based on two parts: a monthly Customer Charge that is billed regardless of the amount of gas used, and a charge for Gas Used that is based on the volume, or hundred cubic feet (ccf), of gas in the current billing period. The heating content of the gas is included by converting the gas used (ccf) into therms.

NOTE: Bill Calculation form only to be used to calculate a one month bill for billing periods between May 1 - October 31.

### To calculate your bill, follow the steps in the sample provided below.

**step 1** Subtract the previous meter reading (last month) from the present meter reading (this month) to determine gas used.

**step 2** Convert ccf into therms.

**step 3** Calculate and add the following charges, which appears as the "Charge For Gas Service" on your bill:
