

What's that *SMELL*?

If you ever notice an odor reminiscent of rotten eggs, you could be smelling natural gas.

Natural gas is actually odorless, so we mix in a very small amount of odorant compounds containing sulphur to give it an unpleasant smell.



If you detect a gas odor, let us track it down. Leave the building immediately and warn others. To avoid creating a spark, do not use the phone at the location (landline or cell). Also, do not turn on or off electrical appliances or light switches and don't access a garage door opener. From a different location, call Laclede Gas to report the odor.
